

Skilled Soft-Tissue and Orthopedic Surgeries

All surgery patients receive preanesthetic blood tests to check the health of organs, as well as an IV catheter and fluids for safety and hydration. During surgery, we monitor your pet's heart rate, blood pressure, level of oxygen in the blood and temperature. In addition to sophisticated monitoring equipment, our certified veterinary technicians provide watchful eyes and caring touches while assisting doctors.

Performing more than 3,000 orthopedic surgeries for 45 area hospitals, he brings expertise in procedures such as cruciate ligament repair and patellar luxation repair, long bone and pelvic fracture repair, and joint stabilization and reconstruction techniques. Dr. Coudrai is certified to take PennHip x-rays to detect hip dysplasia in puppies as young as 4 months of age and is a member of the Veterinary Orthopedic Society. He has also received certification in Canine Rehabilitation Therapy from the Canine Rehabilitation Institute.



Because 85% of pets age 4 and older have dental disease, we want to prevent infection and the spread of harmful bacteria through the mouth into the blood stream and organs such as the heart, liver, lungs and kidneys. A doctor will perform a thorough oral exam while your pet is under anesthesia, measuring gingival pockets to assess overall oral health. Our technicians perform professional dental cleanings with an ultrasonic scaler, polish teeth and provide fluoride treatment. Dental x-rays diagnose the condition of your pet's teeth and jawbone. Our trained and skilled veterinarians perform oral surgery to extract diseased or broken teeth. You'll receive before-and-after photos of your pet's professional dental cleaning and advice on brushing, diet and easy-to-use dental products.

Our veterinarians have completed continuing-education courses at the Animal and Dental Training Center. This advanced training lets us help patients that need surgical tooth extraction, root canals and broken tooth repair.
